What is different or why stay at Raymont?

Accommodation

Is Raymont an approved accommodation provider?

Raymont is an approved accommodation provider for QUT Internationals, UQ, ACU and Aviation Australia.

What type of accommodation is there at Raymont?

We have three options – Single in Primmer block, Single or Twin-Share in Alcorn block. Check out our website for further details.

What is the layout of the accommodation?

We have two accommodation blocks with self-contained units that have 8 or 9 single rooms with private bathrooms off a common area that has a lounge/dining area and kitchenette. There are six twin-share rooms. Laundry facilities are located either within or adjacent to each unit on each floor.

What are some of the other facilities available at Raymont?

Raymont is one of the few residential colleges or accommodation places that has its own pool and there is ample free parking onsite! You will also have access to study areas, a gym and Recreation House where you will be able to relax with friends.

Do I have to provide my own linen?

Yes. The college will provide a mattress protector for your bed. You will need to bring your own bed linen, towels and pillow/s. You are responsible for laundering these items.

Who does the cleaning?

Cleaning of the common area and bathrooms is done by contract cleaners. You are responsible for cleaning your own room during your stay and before departure. You are also responsible for cleaning up any mess that you make in the kitchenette or common areas.

Do I have to vacate my room during semester breaks?

No. You are able to leave your things in your room during the academic year which can be extended or adjusted if you require accommodation prior to or after the normal academic year.

Do I get to choose my own room?

You are able to indicate your preference/s but the College will make the final decision. Returning students have first preference on what room or unit they would like to stay in for their second or successive years.

Is there a curfew?

No, you can come and go as you wish however noise levels need to be limited after 9.30pm and visitors to the premises must leave by 11pm.

Is Raymont an alcohol-free College?

Yes, Raymont Residential College is an alcohol-free place. We do not allow alcohol or drugs on-site in any form. Residents are free to consume alcohol responsibly off-site and are expected to be respectful to fellow residents on their return.

*Catering***Can I still get lunch or a late dinner if I'm not going to be at College for the normal meal-times?**

Yes, for lunch you can grab some extra dinner food the night before or make your own lunch in the morning at the breakfast bar. You will be provided with a plastic Tupperware container that can be used for your lunch or a late meal!

You can pre-order a meal if you're going to be late for dinner or you can get a friend to put something aside for you. You will be provided with a Late Dinner plate and lid to drop off in the Dining Room when you pre-order a late dinner. It will be set aside in the fridge on your return.

I have special dietary requirements, can they be catered for?
